Dos and Don'ts to get the best **Fun Faces**™



Don't crop it before you send it.

We'll do all the cropping to make the best use of the image provided.



Don't send screen shots.

Screen shots are lower quality image and will print pixeled/fuzzy.



Don't download from social media.

Social media images are very low-resolution images, which print very pixeled.

Do have the person stand out from the background.

Making a clear difference (contrast) from the background will end in a cleaner cut.

Avoid photos that heads, or sides of faces are out of frame, including hair.

We try to include as much of the person in the cut out, having images with the top of the heads cut off will result in a flat top/side.

Older photos are fine to use but know that they will be 'soft'.

Photos have improved over the years, so older photos naturally have a poor quality that is just not as crisp as they are these days.

We print what we get.

If the submitted photo is blurry, pixeled, cut off, that is how we will print and cut the image.

Finally, have fun with it!
